Convenient

Children, Inc. Montessori Center at Ninth District is open during the hours that most working families need, 7:00am-6:00pm, Monday through Friday.

The center is open year-round including professional days and summer. The center closes for all major holidays.

Enrollment at the Children, Inc. Montessori Center is open to 3, 4 and 5 year olds who live in the Covington Independent Schools district and can be successful in a group setting with a teacher:student ratio of 1:10. Priority enrollment is given to children enrolled in Ninth District's Montessori program.

Affordable

If a family is not eligible for a discount, the 2011-12 fee for the half day is very affordable at \$18 per half day. The extended full-day program is \$28 per day or \$140 for Monday-Friday.

Sliding scale fees are available to qualifying families through Kentucky's Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP) and the United Way of Greater Cincinnati. Call 859-431-2075 for more information and to see if you qualify.
