We are happy to announce our program expansion to include children ages 24-36 months for full day care. Enrollment is open to 2, 3, 4 and 5 year olds. Priority enrollment is given to children enrolled in Walton-Verona's preschool program. Enrollment is also open to children of Walton-Verona Independent School District employees.

Affordable

Sliding scale fees are available to qualifying families through Kentucky's Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP) and the United Way of Greater Cincinnati. Families that qualify for assistance pay only their assigned co-pay, with no additional tuition fees. Call 859-431-2075 for more information and to see if you qualify.

If a family is not eligible for a discount, the 2014-15 fees are very affordable.
