Please note - Activities and visitors are subject to change.

Children need to bring a bag lunch each day (no microwave items please). Refrigeration is provided. Due to limited space, please do not send coolers or oversized lunch boxes. Morning and afternoon snacks, as well as lunch drinks, will be provided by Children, Inc.

Campers will want to bring money on ice cream days.

Children may not bring electronic devices, such as mp3 players, video games and cell phones.

Current Immunization Certificates and all consent/permission forms are due on the first day of the program. Forms will be mailed to registrants and are also available at www.childreninc.org.



Activities, visits and field trips support weekly themes:

Splash! - Soak up the sun with a fun filled week of splashy water games and activities.

Oh, the Places You'll Go! - Dress up as your favorite book character and get to know some others as we explore Dr. Seuss and friends.

Hooray for Hollywood - Have a blast with your favorite game shows, create costumes fit for Hollywood, and enjoy the show at Coney Island.

Party in the U.S.A. - Celebrate the United States as we gear up for our cookout and a Patriotic Parade.

Fun & Fit - Learn new ways to stay fit and enjoy nutritious foods while having nothing but fun.

Color Crazy - Explore all the crazy colors of our rainbow while enjoying crafts, art projects, and zany games.

Surf's Up! - Sit back, relax, and enjoy a week at the beach, including an under the sea mural and a trip to the pool.

Anything Goes - Wrap up the summer with a final celebration, a trip to the movies and enough fun to last until next summer!

\$135 per week, or \$29 per day (2 days per week minimum)

\$15 Registration Fee per family

\$40 Activity Fee per child

\$5 sibling discount (per additional child) per full week of enrollment

Tuition is due in four installments:

- 1st installment- due with registration
- 2nd installment- due by June 9th
- 3rd installment- due by June 23rd
- 4th installment- due by July 14th

Payment is due in 4 installments even if your child is not registered for that week! Children qualifying for financial assistance MUST pay each Monday. Payments can be made online at www.childreninc.org.

If you register late, you may have to pay more than one installment with your registration, depending on the date.

Tuition assistance is available to families who qualify for free or reduced lunch. If you qualify for tuition assistance, tuition must be paid in weekly installments.

There will be no refunds after May 23rd. Registration fee is non-refundable.

The first installment must be at least 25% of your total tuition, plus the registration and activity fees and must accompany your registration.

Example:

9 weeks @ \$135 = \$1215 x 25% = \$303.75 + \$15 registration + \$40 activity fee = \$358.75 due at registration

6 weeks x 3 days = 18 days x \$29 = \$522 x 25% = \$130.50 + \$15 registration + \$40 activity fee = \$185.50 due at registration

A confirmation letter and a field trip release form will be sent upon receipt of registration and first installment of fees. This letter will include your balance and due dates for subsequent payments.

IMPORTANT:

Save all tuition receipts for tax purposes as a financial statement will not be provided.

Please make sure you complete all information on the registration form, indicating which days and weeks your child will be attending on the reverse side. **Complete one registration form for each child.**
